

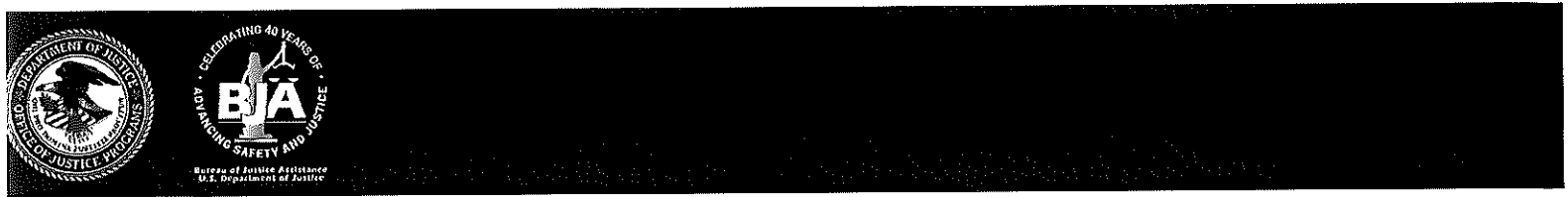

The Caldwell Police Department is requesting funding to purchase necessary equipment that will increase officer safety and directly meet the purpose of the Byrne JAG Program by “improving officer safety by procuring equipment directly related to basic law-enforcement functions.”

The Canyon County Sheriff's Office proposes to use FY 2024 Byrne Jag funds to purchase several items to assist the Canyon County Sheriff Field Services and Security Services this year.

**Item #1. Bean Bag Shotguns**

**Background:** We issue bean bag shotguns to our patrol supervisors

**Justification:** We currently have eight bean bag shotguns for patrol. However, they are very old and at the end of service life

**Cost:** \$4,000.00 to \$6,000.00

**Background:**

We have utilized bean bag rounds for several decades. The rounds are fired from a 12ga shotgun platform. The bean bag round has a one-ounce Kevlar covered bag containing a heavy media inside. This bag expands in flight and on impact with the target. The current shotguns we use for deploying the rounds are approximately 10 to 15 years old and are near the end of their service life.

**Cost:**

The cost of each shotgun is approximately \$431.90. We would need to purchase at least eight to replace the ones we currently have. It would be better to purchase 12 of them and have three per team. This would give us a total of \$3,455.20 for eight or \$5,182.80 for 12. I would also recommend to purchase the orange less lethal stocks. Each stock is \$68.00. The total for eight stocks would be \$544.00 and \$816.00 for 12. This would bring the total for eight shotguns to \$3,999.20 and \$5,998.80 for 12.

Canyon County would be purchasing **12 less lethal shotguns with orange stocks for \$5,998.80.**

**Item #2. 40 MM multi launcher with munitions.**

This less lethal multi launcher would be used in the Canyon County Detention Center. The purpose of this letter is to request the purchase of a 40MM Multi Launcher and munitions. Currently, the only live munitions CERT has is a Pepper ball launcher and Taser which are very useful tools, however they do have limitations and are incident specific. CERT has never had a 40 MM Launcher in its armory. CERT is under prepared for a large-scale incident, such as a riot and is very limited on tools that are accessible. To Safety respond and address an incident of the magnitude, CERT would have to rely on SWAT or other resources outside the Canyon County Detention Center. Time is always a factor and waiting on resources to arrive could jeopardize the safety of the Detention Center, staff and inmates.

Having a 40 MM launcher and munitions readily available in the CERT armory would allow the CERT team to address an incident quickly and safely. CERT is moving in a direction to maintain self-sufficiency without the aid of other tactical teams and having access to a 40 MM launcher and the proper munitions allows Canyon County Sheriff CERT to achieve this. I have attached an estimate for the 40 MM Multi Launcher and the munitions needed to achieve or goals. Please see attached quote from Hurricane Butterfly Law Enforcement and Curtis Blue Line.

**Cost:** 40 MM Multi Launcher with munitions is \$5,578.25. Cost of training munitions is \$1,064.75 for a total of \$6,643.00. Quote attached.

**Item #3. Bosch Blaze 400 electronic laser measuring tool.**

**Background:** Canyon County Sheriff Patrol currently issues a tape measure and small roller wheel to measure accidents and other smaller crime scenes.

**Cost:** \$2,072.00.

**Background:**

When we have an injury or fatal crash, we must take measurements of where the vehicles are located, any skid marks, gouges, debris, how wide the road is, and from a reference point. The measurements are critical when trying to reconstruct the crash for court purposes.

Measurements at an accident scene is completed by laying out a long tape measure on the side of the road from a reference point and then using either a short tape measure or a roller wheel to locate the location of debris and vehicles including skid marks on the roadway. This takes time and is not always very accurate.

By using an electronic laser measuring tool, it will save time and improve accuracy of the measurements. This instrument is accurate within a 1/16<sup>th</sup> of an inch at 400 feet. You simply point the laser at the thing you want to measure and get a distance from your reference point. This can be done by one person for the most part. It also can Bluetooth with a phone or tablet to record the measurements and then overlay them on a photo.

**Item #4. Provide uniform shirts for each member of the communications and warrants section at Canyon County Sheriff's Office.**

Provide uniformed shirts for each member of the communications and warrants sections. Business casual Polo shirt with the Canyon County Sheriff's Office name embroidered on it.

**Background:** The dispatch group wore a uniform 20 years ago, but with no public contact it was decided wearing a uniform on a daily basis was not necessary. A primary benefit of having employees wear uniforms is that it creates a professional appearance. Polo shirts provide a

**Background:** CCSO has an old and outdated throw phone system and does not have Software. CCSO CNT should begin to increase capabilities with available technology.

**Background:**

The current hardware owned by CCSO fieldable by CNT consists of old technology, wired, throw phone system. This system is big and bulky, requires multiple SWAT operators to navigate it, and the wire reel, to any desired area. As well as the trailer must be in close proximity (2000') of the introduction point, which in our rural area is sometime impossible to attain.

It is paramount to collect evidence during a negotiation, allow for team members, leaders, and administrators to monitor an incident in real time, have immediate and effective communication between team members during the response, and while working through the incident itself to completion. All of the information gathered easily becomes part of the incident package in the event it is needed post incident completion as well as easily re-reviewed during the operation if needed for additional or clarifying Intel.

Canyon County Sheriff's (CNT) is requesting to purchase a software App to link any CCSO cell phone during an incident; allowing for seamless transition from one negotiator to another, clear real-time monitoring by others, recording, storing, and archiving of conversations.
