1. Tractor Supply Groundbreaking

Tractor Supply will be holding their groundbreaking ceremony on **April 22nd, 2025 at 1:00 PM** on the company site. NDC commissioners are invited to attend.

2. 11th Avenue Reroute (Public Works - Matt Ricks, Paragon – Joe Barton)

Joe Barton will be joining us today to share updates on the project. Public Works is drafting a formal agreement between NDC and the city for this project. Planned date for construction bid advertisement is July 31, 2025.

NDC approved funding for this project in the amount of 1.6 million dollars. 1.6 million dollars is budgeted for this project in FY25.

3. Downtown Implementation Plan and Feasibility Study

Nathan Davis from Downtown Redevelopment Services is here to update the commission on the downtown work.

There will be a joint City Council Workshop held on April 17th that will finalize the Downtown Implementation Plan.

4. Downtown Cameras

NDC agreed to pay up to \$30,000 for 16 security cameras downtown. The police department worked with City IT on the logistics. The downtown Business Improvement District motioned to approve funding the Premium Support PSA for the cameras in the amount of \$2,599.59 per year starting one year

following installation of the cameras. Installation was completed Friday, March 7, 2025 and will be fully operational at the PD command center this week.

NDC approved funding \$30,000 for the cameras. \$30,000 is budgeted in FY25 budget.

5. Wall Street Beautification

Construction of the trash enclosure is complete. There was a hold up on the rental agreement for the compactor, but this now been completed as well. The rental agreement and utility rates for the compactor will be on a city council agenda in April, once communication with downtown businesses is complete. Once approved, delivery of the compactor is 8-12 weeks out.

NDC approved funding \$122,806 for Wall Street; \$43,696.38 has been spent, \$79,111.12 remains in the budget.
