South Queens Drive UV-CIPP (Option 1): Work Summary: South Queens Dr CIPP Project
Integrity Inspection Solutions will be completing the rehabilitation of a severely damaged 12-inch ADS pipe along South Queens Drive using UV-Cured-In-Place Pipe (UVCIPP) technology. The existing pipe has significant root intrusions causing frequent maintenance issues, and this project aims to restore the structural integrity of the pipeline while preventing future root intrusion.

Scope of Work:
Install a 12-inch UVCIPP liner into the existing 12-inch ADS pipe.

Perform work along designated easements, requiring coordination with local homeowners and Nampa Waterworks to ensure access and minimize disruptions.

Implement a flow-through plug system with a bypass pump to maintain continuous service. Flow will be diverted to a nearby ditch during the liner installation process.

Complete necessary cleaning and root removal prior to liner installation.

Conduct post-installation CCTV inspection to ensure the quality and integrity of the rehabilitated pipeline.

Project Justification:
This rehabilitation is essential to mitigate ongoing maintenance issues caused by root intrusion, which has compromised the structural integrity of the existing pipe. Installing the UVCIPP liner will create a smooth, jointless interior that effectively prevents future root growth and minimizes the need for maintenance.

Stakeholder Collaboration:
The project requires cooperation from adjacent homeowners for access to easements. Collaboration with Nampa Waterworks will be essential to ensure uninterrupted water services and successful bypass pumping. Our team will maintain clear communication throughout the project duration to address any concerns and facilitate a smooth process.

Expected Outcome:
Upon completion, the rehabilitated pipe will have enhanced flow capacity, structural integrity, and long-term resistance to root intrusion, reducing maintenance efforts and improving the overall performance of the wastewater infrastructure.

1. Detailed Site Assessment

Pre-Installation Inspection:

- Conduct thorough CCTV inspections to assess the condition of existing pipelines, identifying obstructions, collapses, or severe corrosion.
- Any necessary cleaning or repairs beyond standard preparation will be subject to additional costs.

Access Evaluation:

- Evaluate access points, such as manholes, for suitability.
- Modifications or additional access points required for equipment entry will incur extra charges.

2. Defined Scope of Work

Standard Inclusions:

- Standard cleaning, liner installation, and post-installation inspections.

Exclusions and Additional Services:

- Heavy cleaning, root removal, bypass pumping, and significant traffic control measures.
- Services not included will be billed separately if required.

3. Change Order Protocol

Unforeseen Conditions:

- A procedure for issuing change orders if unexpected site conditions arise, such as hidden defects or hazardous materials.
- Work halts until a change order is approved by both parties.

Cost Approval:

- Any additional work will commence only after written approval of associated costs from the client.

4. Access and Bypass Requirements

Client Responsibilities:

- Client must provide unobstructed access to the worksite and ensure that existing manholes are accessible and operable.

Bypass Pumping:

- If continuous flow cannot be stopped or diverted by standard means, the provision and operation of bypass pumping systems will be an additional cost.

5. Traffic Control and Permitting

Regulatory Compliance:

- Work along city, county, and state highways will comply with federal, state, and local regulations and safety practices.

Client Coordination:

- Client is responsible for obtaining necessary permits and implementing traffic control measures beyond basic setups.
- Owner will arrange, set up, and tear down all traffic control on state and federal highways at no cost to Integrity Inspection Solutions.
- If Integrity Inspection Solutions must wait for traffic control setup or movement, the Owner will be billed at an hourly rate for the waiting time.

6. Material and Design Adjustments

Liner Thickness Variations:

- Significant deviations in pipe diameter or ovality may require custom liner thicknesses, affecting material costs.

Resin Selection:

- Base proposal includes standard resin systems suitable for typical conditions.
- Specialized resins for aggressive environments will result in additional costs.

7. Warranty and Post-Installation Support

Standard Warranty:

- Defines warranty period and coverage, including defects in materials and workmanship under normal conditions.

Limitations:

- Warranty does not cover issues arising from pre-existing conditions not addressed before installation or from external factors beyond Integrity Inspection Solutions' control.

8. Video Inspection

- Integrity Inspection Solutions will set up on one end to inspect a section of the pipeline.
- If an obstruction prevents inspection of the entire section, Integrity Inspection Solutions will set up on the other end.
- If the section remains inaccessible due to a problem beyond Integrity Inspection Solutions' control, the Owner will be billed for the entire section.

9. Cleaning and Vacuuming Services

Client Responsibilities:

- Owner is responsible for performing cleaning and vacuuming of a section prior to, during, or after an inspection.
- If Integrity Inspection Solutions must wait for Owner's cleaning and vacuuming, the Owner will be billed at an hourly rate.

Hourly Rate:

- Cleaning and vacuuming services will be charged at a specified hourly rate, which includes cleaning, vacuuming, dumping, and obtaining water.

10. Reporting and Documentation

Report and DVD Copies:

- Integrity Inspection Solutions will provide one copy of the DVD and one computer-generated report at the time of inspection.
- Additional copies will be available for a fee of \$250.00 each.

11. Provisions and Site Conditions

Provision of Maps or Drawings:

- Owner must provide sewer system maps or drawings before the crew mobilizes.

Notification and Damages:

- Owner is responsible for notifying residents about cleaning and inspection activities and potential sewer blowback.
- Owner is liable for any damage caused to homes due to sewer blowback.

Collapsed Lines and Inaccessible Manholes:

- Owner is responsible for collapsed lines due to cleaning operations and assisting with equipment extraction if necessary.
- Inaccessible manholes requiring extra work will be charged at an hourly rate of \$380.00 in addition to the linear foot price.

Hydro Cleaning Frequency:

- If a section of pipe or line segment has been cleaned more than four times, an hourly rate of \$250.00/hr will be applied for hydro cleaning in addition to the original quote or quoted per-foot price.

Clear Area and Lid/Opening Clearance:

- Owner shall ensure a clear area at the job location for personnel and equipment.
- Owner shall clear, expose, and mark all lids, covers, or openings for Integrity Inspection Solutions.

Manhole Locating and Clearing:

- If Integrity Inspection Solutions is required to locate and/or clear manholes or wait for Owner crews, it will be billed at an hourly rate of \$250.00/hr.

Fire Hydrant and Debris Disposal:

- Owner must provide a fire hydrant within 1/2 mile of the work site.
- Owner is responsible for providing a dump site for debris removal and all disposal costs.
- Disposal shall comply with all federal, state, and local regulations.

12. Standby Time and Proposal Validity

Standby Charges:

- If Integrity Inspection Solutions crews are unable to perform the scheduled work promptly upon arrival, standby time charges will apply.
