SUBJECT:	Action Item: Authorize Engineering Division to proceed with the formal bid process for the Grimes City Pathway Extension Phase 2 (McDonagh Park to 11th Ave North) project. (Standard bid documents and contracts approved by Legal) (Approved in 1st Amendment of FY24 Budget - funding from Streets Division)

Background Summary:

- The Grimes City Pathway Extension is one segment of the planned Orah Brandt Park to Star Road bike and pedestrian path. The path is identified in Nampa's 2020 Bike and Pedestrian Master Plan with the segment from Birch Lane through McDonagh Park already complete. This segment connects McDonagh Park to 11th Ave North
- The City of Nampa applied for and received federal funding for design and construction of the extension of the Grimes Pathway from McDonagh Park to Birch Elementary (Exhibit A - Vicinity Map)
- Design was completed January 2024. The contemplated action of this Engineering Business item is to obtain authorization to initiate and complete the formal bidding process for this project. Provided bids are within the planned budget, a forthcoming Engineering Business item will be submitted to Council for the eventual award of a Contract for construction of this project

Reason for Project:

- This project will provide safe off-street access to the surrounding neighborhoods, Birch Elementary School, McDonagh Park, Sunset Oaks Park and Centennial Golf Course

- This extension is part of the long-term plan to have Grimes Creek Pathway extend to the east, connecting to the College of Western Idaho and the Idaho Center

Funding/Project Costs:

- This project was initially funded with Surface Transportation Block Group - Urban (STBG-U) funding. COMPASS and the Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) have since changed the Federal Funding source to Carbon Reduction fund with no net effect to the City nor the project budget
- The project is funded 92.66% with Carbon Reduction funds secured through COMPASS with the City of Nampa providing 7.34% match from the Parks FY24 budget. The total project cost is currently estimated at \$719,282.00, of which Nampa's match is anticipated to be \$52,795.30
- The City has paid \$1,000.00 up front to Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) for administration fees which will be applied toward City match

Staff Recommendation:

- Staff recommend that Council authorize Engineering Division to proceed with the formal bid process for the Grimes City Pathway Extension Phase 2 (McDonagh Park to 11th Ave North)
