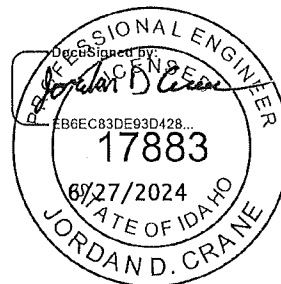

PROCEDURE: Clarifications/modifications to the bidding documents by formal addendum.

DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT:

- Work consists of installing two new pressure reducing valve stations (PRVs) in the right-of-way at the intersection of Caldwell Boulevard/Middleton Road and West of Middleton Road along Flamingo Avenue, approximately 2,300 feet of new 12-inch water main in the right-of-way along Midway Road between Karcher Road and Moss Lane, approximately 250 feet of new 12-inch water main in the right-of-way along Moss Lane between Midway Road and Asbury Drive, asphalt repair, miscellaneous surface repairs, and traffic control.

BIDDING REQUIREMENTS:

- Bid opening – 2:00pm local time, July 02, 2024, at City Development Services Building.
- Bid Docs: Bid Form, Bid Bond, Naming of Subcontractors

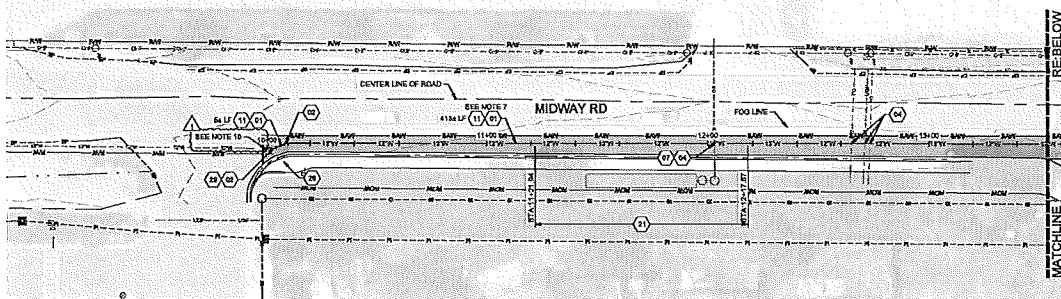
SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

- Work to be performed in accordance with the 2012 ISPWC and City of Nampa Supplemental Specification to the ISPWC, except as modified in the bid documents.
- Permitting
 - Contractor shall obtain and pay for all needed permits including a City of Nampa Erosion and Sediment Control Permit
 - City has obtained the ITD Permit for the PRV in the right-of-way at the intersection of Caldwell Boulevard and Middleton Road, see Appendix A of the bidding documents.
- Profile/Utility Crossings
 - No potholing was completed, location and depth of utilities will be confirmed by the Contractor.
 - Contractor shall pothole all utility crossings at least 500 feet in front of excavation.
- Potable Water Service Disruptions
 - Depressurization events to be limited to 4 hours.
 - Water mains shall not be depressurized for longer than 8 hours without providing temporary water services to affected residences.
 - Coordinate with the City and affected customers at least 48 hours prior to depressurization event.
 - Anticipated affected services include
 - Chevron gas station on Midway Rd. and Karcher Rd.

- One service on Flaming Ave. just south of the PRV location
- ITD Permit for work in Caldwell Blvd. and Middleton Rd.
 - ITD Permit in Appendix A of the bid docs
 - Material submittals for work in ITD ROW need to be submitted to and approved by ITD
 - Traffic control plan is provided in the permit and has been approved by ITD
 - **Night work only** (10:00 pm – 5:00 am)
- Miscellaneous
 - Trench backfill within City of Nampa right-of-way shall be Type I (ISPWC 802.2.2).
 - Trench backfill within ITD right-of-way shall be lean concrete backfill per detail B3 of sheet C-501 of the plans.
 - PRVs shall be installed per detail A1 of sheet C-501 of the plans.
 - Low density polyethylene liner shall be installed from stations 11+21.94 through 12+17.87, 18+67.74 through 19+38.89, and 23+86.65 through 24+52.75.
 - Work at Karcher Rd. and Middleton Rd. being completed by other that will also construct part of the piping/valves needed to create Pressure Zone 1. Leave valves and PRVs open until City coordinates the efforts to create Pressure Zone 1.

Contractor Questions

1. *What is the approximate start date for the project?*
 - a. *The City anticipates getting Council approval to move forward with the project on 7/15/2024. It is anticipated that the project will be able to start at the end of July.*
2. *City records show a blow off at the end of the existing 12-inch waterline at station 10+00 on Midway Rd but it was not located.*
 - a. *A general sheet note will be added to sheet C-301 to remove the blow off if found. If it is found, removal of the blow off will be incidental to the work.*



SEGMENT 3 - MIDWAY ROAD WATER LINE

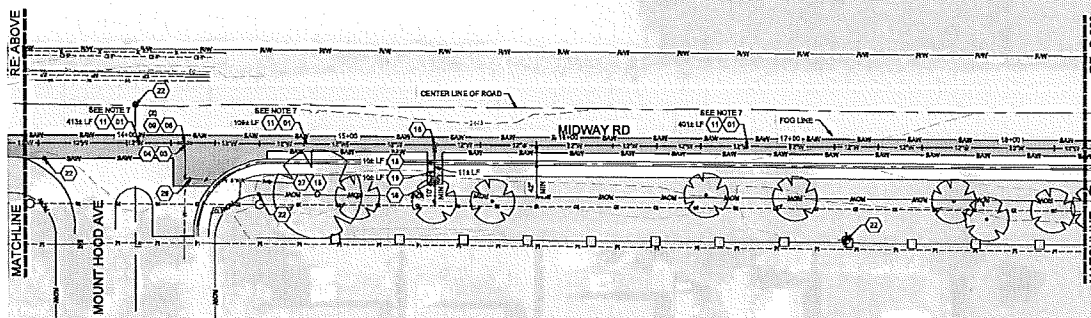


GENERAL SHEET NOTES

1. PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION, CONTRACTOR TO PORTHOLE IN A NON-DESTRUCTIVE MANNER EXISTING UTILITIES TO VERIFY LOCATION & DEPTH. WHERE EXISTING UTILITIES WILL BE ENCOUNTERED IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE CONTRACTOR HIRE DIG OR VACUUM TRUCK EXCAVATE FOR MATERIAL EXCAVATION.
