Background Summary:

A Community Resource Center is a coalition of multiple community partners servicing significant community needs in the following areas:

Educational support programs, employment assistance, health services, and social services. The target population primarily includes the Hispanic/Latino residents of north Nampa but must be open to all community members in need.

Upon council's approval of the acceptance of the application, the City will request authorization of a lease agreement during the August 19, 2024 city council meeting.

Reason for Project:

Due to community need and recent closure of the previous Family Community Resource Center at Snake River Elementary, we desire to open a new resource center as soon as possible.
