



## MEMORANDUM

**RE:** Authorize bidding Indian Creek Pathway Repair

The Nampa Parks Division is requesting to reallocate FY 23 capital funding. In FY 23, Nampa Parks received the approved budget of \$150,000 to repair a failing portion of Indian Creek Pathway. In addition, a budget of \$60,000 was approved to make repairs to the Amphitheater located at Lakeview Park. We request City Council approve to reallocate the \$60,000 dollars that was earmarked for the Amphitheater and use that funding toward the Indian Creek Pathway Project. This would provide a \$210,000 budget to complete the pathway project.

In an informal bidding process, the Parks Division received three bids for the Indian Creek Pathway Project. All bids received were over budget and exceeded \$200,000. Due to the bids coming in higher than expected, we rejected all bids and will need to go through a formal bidding process. The ability to fund the pathway repair is a top priority because it will eventually be unusable if the problem is not addressed. Funding to repair the Amphitheater will be requested next year in the FY 24 budget.

In summary, the Nampa Parks and Recreation Department requests \$60,000 in the FY 23 budget, that was originally intended be used for the Lakeview Amphitheater, be reallocated for the repair of the Indian Creek Pathway. Staff also requests authorization to go out to bid for the Indian Creek Pathway Project.

### Action Items:

Authorize Parks and Recreation funding and bidding for Indian Creek Pathway Project

**A.** Nampa Parks and Recreation Department requests authorization to reallocate \$60,000, of the FY 23 Budget, designated to the Lakeview Park Amphitheater, be used for the repair of the Indian Creek Pathway Project.

**B.** Authorize the Parks and Recreation Department to advertise and accept bids for the Indian Creek Pathway Repair Project.
