SUBJECT: Council Agenda Item #1-6.a. – Alcohol Renewal Licenses for 2023-2024

Attached are alcohol renewal licenses submitted for your consideration and approval.

Licenses listed on **Exhibit A** have submitted all documentation for approval.

Licenses listed on **Exhibit B** have been submitted for approval contingent upon the issuance of State and/or County Licenses. These licenses will not be issued until all required documents have been submitted to the Clerk's office.

The following establishments currently have points assessed against their license.

- **Buffalo Wild Wings** has 0.5 point assessed which reached the minor offense category and it will come off their record on May 25, 2023.
- **La Copa** has 2.0 points assessed which reached the minor offense category and it will come off their record on January 25, 2024.
- **Maverick #287** has 0.5 point assessed which reached the minor offense category and it will come off their record on May 25, 2023.
- **Pete's Tavern** has 2.0 points assessed which reached the minor offense category and it will come off their record on May 25, 2023.
- **Tiny's Cocktail and Lounge** has 2.0 points assessed which reached the minor offense category and it will come off their record on May 25, 2023

Provided below is information from the City's Legal team for when Council is reviewing alcohol renewal licenses:

Nampa City Code states that the City Council may (optional) require as a condition of an issuance or any renewal of an alcohol beverage license that the licensee and/or its employees complete specialized liquor law enforcement training offered by the City of Nampa Police Department and/or the Idaho State Police. (5-12-6).

*The mayor and council may deny a license renewal application for a licensee **having accumulated at least three points** against their license since their most recent license renewal or issuance. Renewal of such licenses may only be granted by the city council after a public hearing at which the licensee or license applicant*

appears in person to provide testimony to demonstrate that procedures have been put in place that in the discretion of the city council are designed to avoid and reduce future violations.

Licenses without the assignment of at least three points may be renewed by consent agenda through the city council. When the mayor and council deny a license, or refuse to renew a license, they shall specify, in writing, the statutes, ordinances and standards used in evaluating the application, the reasons for denial, and the actions, if any, that the applicant could take to obtain the license, transfer, or renewal. The foregoing shall be provided the applicant, in writing, within 30 days of a decision to deny an application. (5-12-17)
