SUBJECT:	Action Item: By Resolution, authorize Mayor to sign Cooperative Agreement with the Idaho Transportation Department for the I-84, Karcher Interchange Project for fire hydrant relocation and landscaping improvements (Project No. A023(336); Key No. 23336). (Approved by Legal) (Approved in FY23 Budget)

Background Summary:

- Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) is completing their design on the I-84-Karcher Interchange (IC) Project (project)
- The project includes the reconfiguration of the eastbound and westbound off-ramps of the Karcher IC, widening of SH-55 to three lanes in the westbound direction from the interchange to Middleton Rd, and various pedestrian improvements
- The design/construction will relocate City of Nampa (City) fire hydrants, modify City traffic signals, and relocate landscaping near the interchange

Reason for Project:

- The project will reduce stacking on the interstate and may improve traffic flow at the Karcher IC by adding a third westbound lane on the overpass

Funding/Project Costs:

- Per the Agreement (Exhibit A), the City will pay an estimated \$28,000 for design, labor, materials and equipment
 - \$20,000 for hydrant relocation (Exhibit B)
 - \$8,000 for landscaping (Exhibit C)

Staff Recommendation:

- City staff support entering into the Cooperative Agreement with ITD for fire hydrant relocation and landscaping associated with ITD's Karcher Interchange Project
